



## How to become an AHSAA Soccer Official for NASOA

**The AHSAA soccer season is as follows:**

**Registration: November-Early April**

**Pre-training: December - January**

**Season: February - May**

### **1. Register with AHSAA (Alabama High School Athletic Association)**

- Register through Dragonfly at <https://www.dragonflymax.com>  
Cost = \$74.92 (\$50 for registration \$10 for Background Check)+\$4.92
- Upper right Select Login/SignUp
- Either LOG IN if you have an account or SIGN UP FOR FREE
- As you register you will select
  - **AHSAA and then SC702 North Alabama Soccer as the Association ID.**
- If you Had and account already:
  - Once you log in select your profile in the left side panel and chose My Info
  - When your account info comes up under Get Ready you should see AHSAA and the 2023-24 with a Red Dot.
  - Select that and it should run you through the registration process for 2023-24
- If you DID NOT have an account already and this is a new account:
  - Once you select sign up for free there will be an account validation process. You will need to have access to the email address you enter.
  - Once you validate and accept the terms of service, you connect to your state association.
  - Select Official. Select Contest Official. Add Contest Official. Select Alabama.
  - Now Select AHSAA Alabama High School Athletic Association and Join
  - Select Soccer and Add Soccer.
  - Find SC702 North Alabama Soccer and Add Group for Soccer.
  - Once added then proceed from the “If you had and account already above”
  - Following instructions to register AND background check. You may have to update or add your demographic information for AHSAA 2023-243 and SC702 2023-24.

### **2. TAKE TEST**

There is a section to take the AHSAA Certification Test. **Do not take test until you have updated book.** Check our website for the latest information. Rules book are handed out at the first association meeting of the preseason.

### **3. SET YOUR BLOCKS on DragonFly Max app.**

Remember if you are doing HASL and/or USSF Youth then you MUST maintain your blocks on both systems Dragonfly and GameOfficials. If you are assigned a game in either system you must block that time in the other system in order not to be double booked. PLEASE KEEP TRACK.

### **4. TRAINING PRESEASON**

Attend our tune up clinic in January. Especially new referees. Details on NASOA website. This is very important! Please make every effort to attend.
